

M.E. Companion William C. Eppig Most Excellent Grand High Priest 2018-2019

Bill was installed as Grand High Priest at the Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter of Maryland on October 27, 2018.

Bill has lived in the Baltimore area all his life and began his Masonic journey in 1978 when he joined Catonsville-Palestine Chapter Order of DeMolay. DeMolay became a big part of his life and was very active in his chapter and received many awards and recognitions while an active member that includes the Blue Honor Key, PMC-MSA, and Chevalier Degree.

He was elected and served as Master Councilor of Catonsville in 1981 and had the honor to serve the State Association when elected as State Chaplain of Maryland DeMolay in 1982. Bill served 3 years in elected office before being elected as State Master Councilor of Maryland for 1985-1986 term.

After becoming a Senior DeMolay. Bill served as an advisor for Catonsville Chapter and was on the state staff of the State Association

for many years. In 1997 Bill was asked to serve as Executive Secretary for Maryland DeMolay and in 2007 he became Executive Officer. Some of the highlights of his years as Executive Officer is when he received the Cryptic Masons Youth Award, The John C. Naquin Youth Award, and the DeMolay International Eagle Award for Executive Officer of the Year. But the best highlight was seeing so many young men become outstanding adults through **DeMolay**

Though active in DeMolay he found time for Masonry. Bill joined Mt Nebo Lodge #229 in 1987 and is now a member of Warren Lodge #51. In 2015 Bill received the Warren Seipp medal and was honored in 2018 when appointed as Grand Tyler for the Grand Lodge of Maryland. Both were unexpected honors and will always be grateful.

He joined the Scottish Rite of Maryland in 1997 and was recognized as a KCCH in 2011. Bill is a member of the 21st Degree team. York Rite was not far behind.

In 2000 Bill Joined Druid Chapter #28, Hiram Council #5, and Crusade Commandery #5. Bill really liked the York Rite and the Chapter in particular and became High Priest of Druid in 2004. A few years later he served as Illustrious Master of the Council. He became a member of the AMD, Knight Masons and Royal Arc Mariners and was privileged to serve as the head of each. This led to his desire to serve the Grand Chapter and stood for election as Grand Scribe in May 2014 and Installed that October.

Bill has worked in the paint industry for going on 30 years starting at Duron Paints in 1990. Duron was purchased by Sherwin Williams Paint Co. 2001. Bill has been in-store management since 1992.

One of the greatest things to happen is when he met his wife Robin. They have been married for 27 years and she has been a big part of his life. She knew nothing of Masonry or the Masonic family but became active and very supportive of her husband over the years. So much so they both are members of Gleaner Chapter OES. He can honestly say if it was not for her love and support he would not have accomplished what he has over the years.

3. Semi-Annual Proceedings

M.E. Comp. Vernon H. Huebschman

MEGHP,

The Proceedings of the 2019 Semi-Annual Grand Convocation have been available on the Grand Chapter website. They include the Minutes of the Council of Anointed High Priests for May 2019. As they have been available for inspection and review, and will continue to be so, I move that they be accepted as posted, subject for further correction should any cause be found.

4. Report of the Grand Secretary

M.E. Comp Vernon H. Huebschman

Most Excellent Grand High Priest,

- 1. Membership The Summary Report which is provided on the reverse of the Agenda shows the data supplied by the Secretaries of each of our constituent Chapters. I will leave to others to tease out the nuances that hide in the data points.
- 2. Mergers The Summary Report deals with the mergers of Ithiel Chapter No. 27 in Druid Chapter No. 28, and St. Johns Chapter No. 19 into Adoniram Chapter No. 21. We are indebted to those who worked on these transitions that they went as well as they did.
- 3. Secretaries I would like to express my sincere thanks to the Chapter Secretaries who labored for the good management of their respective Chapters. One Companion in each Chapter bears the responsibility for Membership management, communications, billing, history, record keeping, and coordination with the Grand Chapter. The Secretary must understand the Constitution of the Grand Chapter and the Bylaws of his own Chapter. Each year he must adapt to the programs of a new High Priest or buttress the efforts of a High Priest who is serving multiple terms. Our Secretaries have a partner on the opposite side of the room in the Treasurer. It is his duty to keep a spotless record of the transactions of the Chapter and be sure the honor of the Chapter is pristine. I don't know of a single man who is a Secretary or Treasurer by birth, and few who have the specific training in management to hold these positions. They accept election because they know the life of their beloved Chapter depends on having someone in the Southeast Corner of the Chapter Room. No Secretary is perfect. Each Companion has his own set of skills, and an allowance of time and energy to devote to this position. This means performance among our Chapters varies. Each Secretary does what he can with his talent and time. Please be grateful for his service and assist where you can. The greatest help is to respond quickly to dues notices, and requests for information...give timely responses so issues can be expeditiously resolved. Respect your Secretary's time. I have often heard it said that being a Secretary is a thankless job. Well, it should not be so.
- 4. School for Secretaries, Recorders, and Treasurers The third such School is scheduled for February 15, 2020...the third Saturday in February. This date is selected to coordinate with the Grand Masters Conference of North America which causes a lull in the Grand Master's regional Meetings. Comp. Charles Matulewicz, the appointed Asst Grand Secretary, is tasked with organization this school for 2020. Requests for honing specific skills and practices will narrow the scope of some of the topics we have covered in the past. Please mark your calendars and cooperate with Companion Matulewicz in his first major effort.
- 5. Committees Thanks to those who labored and provided the reports of their efforts. This year has been of model of great improvement in effort by our Committees. This is a combination of the leadership of the MEGHP and the diligence of the Companions who accepted his challenges to serve. The results speak for themselves and deserve your respectful approval.
- 6. IRS 990 N Reports Several of our Chapters are recovering from the loss of their Not for Profit Status. This happens when a Secretary loses his focus on his obligations. This process costs \$600 and many hours of effort. These reports are due after March 31st each year. They take 15

- minutes to do, and it is 100% done on the internet. Each Chapter must make sure their officers are seeing to this obligation because the cost of reinstatement is significant when seen as a cost per member. Any officer can do this report. Maintaining the Not for Profit status is necessary to have an Employer Identification Number or EIN. Without the EIN, banks and financial institutions will not do business or establish accounts to serve your Chapter.
- 7. Petition Vetting All petitions for the Chapter Degrees must be vetted with the Grand Secretary of the Grand Chapter. No other officer or other personal knowledge of Lodge actions is acceptable because the Grand Chapter is responsible to the Grand Lodge of Maryland that its Constitutional requirements for proficiency are upheld. There were several instances this Capitular Year when Chapters did not vet their petitioners and the GLMMS did not show they had stood a satisfactory proficiency. This is an offense for the Petitioners who are told in the Master Mason Degree admonitions that they may not proceed to other bodies until and unless they exemplify in the Catechism of the MM Degree. The Grand Chapter is the gate keeper for the York and bears the responsibility to the Grand Lodge to see that York Rite petitioners comply with the Grand Lodge Law.
- 8. Retirement It is still my intention to retire from the offices of Grand Secretary and Grand Recorder in October 2020. I have been sharing my experiences with the elected grand officers and the designated Assistant Grand Secretary. My main concern is the preservation of a unified York Rite Database. This body of facts provides an invaluable tool for the care of the memberships of our Companions. The GLMMS is a wonderful asset to assist in the maintenance of this information but I cannot see that the GLMMS has the capacity of doing the same things that the YR Database does at this point. The Grand Encampment's membership information provides me no comfort in data integrity and the sovereignty of each of the other two Grand Bodies. Somehow the YR Database must remain one unified body of information for Chapter and Council. As an example of its utility, the Grand Commandery has to back feed information concerning its past officers and current dais officers to make possible the cost savings in unified mailings for our annual and semi-annual grand meetings. I urge our leadership to take great care with this imperfect but priceless tool that Companion Gene Racz built a quarter of a century ago from index cards and scraps of paper.

Thank you, MEGHP, for a spectacular year under your leadership. Every Companion who presides has a unique vision and set of gifts...and his own goals. ME Companion Eppig, you are among the very best I have served and observed in my 35 years in Royal Arch Masonry. Thank you for the hours of planning, the coordination meetings, the follow up with your officers and committee chairmen, and the miles you have logged in traveling America in Miniature from the ocean to the mountains. From the Eastern Shore to the rest of Maryland. You have earned our undying respect for your accomplishments.

In the interest of clarity and confusion abatement I have sent out an email to all Chapter Secretaries requesting that they read out Section 5, Subsections (a), (b), and (c) of Article XII Subordinate Chapters of the Constitution and Standing Resolutions of the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of Maryland and that they be entered into the minutes of the relevant Convocation.

I have visited ten Chapters to date. All but one of them have conferred the Mark Master and Past Master Degrees with Casts predominated by their own Companions. The Most Excellent Master and Royal Arch Degree conferral continue to challenge most Chapters and necessitate presiding officer roles being filled by Companions from other Chapters. However, the pool of Companions competent to fill High Priest, Right Worshipful Master, Captain of the Host, and Principal Sojourner roles continues to grow.

Schools of Instruction are planned for Mt. Vernon RAC No. 25 in November and one centrally located on the Eastern Shore early next year. Sincerely,

The First Grand York Rite Festive Board was held on Monday September 30, 2019 in the Grand Lodge of Maryland ballroom at 7:30 PM. Our guest speaker was Companion Charles Matulewicz who gave a nice presentation on "The building and rebuilding of the Temple as a Masonic Metaphor".

The food, soft drinks, and table ware were provided by Atlantic Caterers. A total of 7 honorary tickets were provided for the MWGM, RWDGM/SGIG, MEGHP, MIGM, REGC, Guest Speaker and the Photographer. There were a total of 43 tickets sold plus the seven honorary tickets for a projected attendance of 50 people. The Total Income generated from ticket sales at \$30.00 each was \$1,290.00, the Total Expenses including the Ballroom rental was \$1,867.33. Report of the Grand Chapter/Council Committee for the Proposed Hagerstown Mergers: Ithiel Royal Arch Chapter No. 27 with Druid Royal Arch Chapter No. 28 Palestine Council No. 16 R&SM with Hiram Council No. 5 R&SM

The untimely death of beloved Secretary/Recorder Terry Smith on August 25, 2018, left Comp. R. Joseph White (MEHP of Ithiel Chapter No. 27 and TIM of Palestine Council No. 16) as the only regularly active member of these two Hagerstown bodies. Comp. White had sought assistance from the membership (of about 38) and found little interest in supporting either body. He then made known his intention to seek a merger with Druid RAC No. 28 and Hiram Council No. 5 R&SM in Cockeysville, MD.

Agreeably to their respective Constitutions MEGHP Eppig and MIGM Lumbert appointed a Dual Committee to respond to the intended merger and supervise the details of transition. The Hagerstown Merger Committee consists of PGHP/MIPGM Stephen J. Ponzillo, III, PGHP/RIDGM Randall L. Watson, and MIPGM/RIG Treasurer John A. Rafine.

Notice was made to the membership and a Joint Convocation/Assembly of Ithiel Royal Arch Chapter No. 27 and Palestine Council No. 16 R&SM was held Monday, November 5, 2018 with the following attending: MEHP/TIM R. Joseph White; MEGHP William C. Eppig; REGK Bruce G. Colburn; MIGM Robert B. Lumbert, PGHP; RIDGM Randall L. Watson, PGHP; TIM/EK John P. Mitchell; PTIM/ES William C. Hare; and Grand Secretary/Grand Recorder Vernon H. Huebschman, PGHP.

After some discussion describing the intended action, a motion was made, seconded, and unanimously approved for a merger under the following terms:

- 1. Ithiel Chapter No. 27 desired to cease operation, and merge into Druid Chapter No. 28.
- 2. Palestine Council No. 16 desired to cease operation, and merge into Hiram Council No. 5.
- 3. Each body would surrender all its respective assets, property, and paraphernalia to the target
- 4. Each Hagerstown body was current on all its financial responsibilities and would continue to meet all its obligations until the merger is agreed upon by the target bodies.
- 5. A second opportunity for the Ithiel/Palestine members to consider this action would be available at the stated Convocation/Assembly on December 3, 2018, if a voting quorum was present. If no quorum was available at that meeting, the decision on the motion at the November 5, 2018 Convocation/Assembly would stand as their final decision.
- 6. That Druid and Hiram would respectively accept and honor the dues remissions status (and Life Memberships) of current Hagerstown members as permanent, should the merger proposals be ratified.
- 7. Upon the approval to merge by Druid/Hiram, the operation of Ithiel and Palestine would be immediately suspended pending confirmation by the MEGHP & MIGM and the voice of their Grand Bodies.
- 8. Upon merger ratification, all Hagerstown members would be transferred into Druid Chapter and Hiram Council.
- 9. Dues paid by Hagerstown members to the Hagerstown Bodies before the vote to approve the merger by Druid and Hiram would be deemed as paid in their new bodies for 2019.
- 10. A window of six months would be open to allow Hagerstown members who wished to belong elsewhere to transfer to other Maryland Chapters and Councils; if those bodies will not accept the transfers without affiliation fees, such fees would be paid by the appropriate Hagerstown body for the transferring members.

11. The physical properties of the Hagerstown bodies were in long term storage, and would become available when Friendship Lodge secured its permanent home, and emptied the storage unit.

The proposed merger was announced to the members of Druid Royal Arch Chapter No. 28 and Hiram Council No. 5 R&SM and scheduled for a vote on February 28, 2019. Hiram Council opened at 7:00 pm on that date and approved the merger and terms as proposed by Palestine Council. Druid Chapter opened at 7:30 pm and approved the merger and terms as proposed by Ithiel Chapter. This was reported at the May 2019 Semi-Annual Grand Convocation and Grand Assembly.

The Grand Secretary / Grand Recorder has transferred the 38 Ithiel/Palestine members into Druid/Hiram. He has been informed that three of the Hagerstown members have approached Enoch RAC No. 23 (and Enoch Council No. 10 R&SM) in Frederick, and Salem RAC No. 18 (and Salem Council No. 11 R&SM in Cumberland) about seeking a more convenient Mother Chapter. If they are accepted, their transfers will be made to the new Chapter/Council.

The Hagerstown bodies' financial accounts will be closed and the funds will be transmitted to Druid/Hiram in the near future.

I have a short speech for the open installation, but I wanted to speak to the members about a few items of our concern and planning.

THANK YOU:

First, I want to thank the members for giving me this opportunity to lead the Grand Chapter of Maryland for the ensuing year. It is an honor and responsibility I take very seriously. I especially want to thank Vernon and John for all the knowledge and help they have provided to me in understanding the nuts and bolts of the Grand Chapter. These two powerhouses, do so much behind the scenes, and keep the train on the tracks for the rest of us. Also thanks to Bill, who, over a period of months, listened to my ideas and told me his, to come up with mutual long range plan of where we wanted to see Royal Arch Masonry go over our two years. Past Grand High Priests, your experience and thoughts are highly valued by this next Grand High Priest. And thank you to all my officers and committee members for either continuing in the work you do, or stepping up for new challenges.

HISTORY:

My Masonic history is not full of Masonic honors. I was Master Councilor of Glen Burnie Demolay in 1970. I was raised in Waverly Lodge in 1978, because my father and uncles belonged, though my father had passed away prior to my joining. I then got busy with working, being in the Marine Corps active reserve, married, going to school for a degree, and raising children, which left little time for Masonic activities. My biggest activity then was probably serving pancakes for several years in the barn at Bonnie Blink. Later, I joined Glen Burnie Lodge and then in 2007 my friend Richard said "we should join York Rite and become Knights Templars". Well, being a history buff, once I got into the Royal Arch and studied the historical relations between it and the Blue Lodge (and being coerced into ritual work by Bob Lumbert and Fred Spicer), I found a home. And my Masonic activities have been there ever since. Yes, I belong to the Scottish Rite, the Tall Cedars, and the Boumi Shrine, AMD, the Virginia Civil War Lodge of Research, and the York Rite College. But Royal Arch is my center.

GOALS:

Goals for the coming year, I have a few.

First, membership. I want EVERY Maryland Mason to understand why he needs to be a Royal Arch Mason. Not just to receive the lost word, but because he has not really completed the third degree. Several places in the third degree refer to a future time that go unexplained. And because the Chapter gives him the opportunity to meet other Masons in the community of lodges in his area. And because he returns to his Blue Lodge a more informed and active member.

Second, to increase our visibility and assistance to the Blue Lodges. The future of Royal Arch Masonry lies with the future of the Symbolic lodges. When they need attendance or assistance with functions, talks, or help with degrees, and our members are doing those things, we need to show up with some form of identifying item (red jacket, red shirt, red vest, red tie, etc.) that lets

the lodge know a Royal Arch Mason is helping them. Our active blue lodge members are our best form of recruitment.

Which leads to the

Third goal, increasing our number of "active" members. Many Chapters are working with less than 10 active members, while having membership rolls of 100 or more. Since most only meet one night a month, the excuse of too many meetings doesn't make sense. Maybe our meetings need to have better refreshments, less meeting time and more social time, or interesting speakers. High Priests, DO SOMETHING, you have the ability. I don't want to hear about ideas, I want to see actions. There's nothing wrong with a brief meeting, followed by some social time over a few beers and snacks or dinner. Or meeting the ladies afterwards for dinner. or at a local ice cream shop, whatever.

Fourth, this Grand Chapter should have the responsibility of organizing and sponsoring a few social activities for all Royal Arch Masons and prospective members, in Maryland. There is no better way to show our fellowship than getting us all together more than twice a year, just to talk, make new friends, and enjoy ourselves. MEGHP Eppig and I started this with the distillery tours, the King's bowling tournament, and the October event, and it will continue, and grow in participation, I hope.

Fifth, degree work. We have got to strive to get away from the books during degrees. Once we have a candidate who says "yes, I'd like to know more", we have to present our work as well or better than the Blue Lodges. That is what they will judge us against as far as our sincerity in what we do.

(note!) Mention Reports in on time

Grand visitations should be a way to introduce the members to the Grand officers, inform the members of what the Grand Chapter is doing, and give members an opportunity to have a oneon-one with Grand officers to exchange ideas, complaints, and guestions. I have posted my planned dates for Grand visitations on the web site. I expect the current High Priests to contact me prior to their date if any changes need to be made, or if our assistance is needed for degree work. If Chapters wish to combine their visitations with another Chapter, we can work that out.

In closing, I look forward to working with the Grand Lodge, the Scottish Rite, the Grand Council and the Grand Commandery as we move forward in the coming year. Thank you.

Not to mention the many charities that each individual chapter supports, such as Sarah's House and NCEON, here in Anne Arundel County. Plus financial and time support for the various Masonic youth organizations. This money comes from our members, in the form of personal individual contributions, and in fund raising events.
