### **Grand Treasurer's Report**

MIGM,

The attached spread sheet is the bulk of the assets held by the Grand Council of R&SM of Maryland. The funds operated by the Grand Recorder can be added to this spreadsheet on the bottom line where a open cell awaits the balance.

All assets and funds in the portfolio have trended downward over the period following the last Annual Report given at the Semi-Annual Grand Assembly in May 2015. The Final Annual Report will be prepared and presented to the Semi-Annual Grand Assembly in May 2016. A phone consultation with Holly Tilford, Vice President, our financial adviser found each investment to be appropriate to continue for the time being. At present, the cash account has again accumulated to a total of \$8,392.62. A single check has been written against this balance to transfer to the operating accounting managed by the Grand Recording in the amount of \$6,500.00

As a recommendation to those looking forward to our budgets moving to the next Triennial Assembly, it is believed that this will be held on the West Coast. I would recommend that additional provision be made for funding the travel of those Grand Officers required to attend this event.

Also, our constituent Councils should be aware that the General Grand Council has acted on the annual assessment to the international body.

Again, thank you for this opportunity to serve this Grand Council and you personally during your two years of service to Maryland. I intend 2015-2016 to be my final year of service as Grand Treasurer and urge this body to search out a better qualified and more competent Companion to manage the financial affairs of this Grand Council.

**MIGM Report  
Annual Assembly  
October 24, 2015**

Companions,

I would like to welcome everyone to the Annual assembly here in Ocean City, and thank you for your support of your Grand Council. I would also like to thank the MIPGM's in attendance today. It is through your dedication that this Grand Council continues to grow. Also to the Grand Officers, who give of their time and talents to assist in this task.

I would like to thank MEGHP Randall Watson and REGC Randolph Disney, for their cooperation, friendship and dedication to this fraternity. We all know that one body cannot exist without the other. And if the Grand Bodies cannot Unify, then what hope can there be for the local bodies? Does it exist?

In my opinion, it does. Not in all areas of the State but in certain pockets you see Companions on the local level not thinking as “we are RAM companions or R&SM companions or even Sir Knights of the Commandery” instead you see them coming together as a combined York Rite group and not worrying about one or the other “getting the glory”. This is true **York Rite Unity**

I would also like to thank the Grand Lodge and MWGM Kenneth Wyvill for his support of this unity. GM Wyvill has continued the ability for all subordinate bodies to visit lodges and present the York Rite message, and urges us to do so.

### **Super Excellent Master Degree**

On April 4 at the Scottish Rite Temple in Baltimore, the Grand Council once again conferred the SEM. This turned out to be a wonderful day of fellowship and fun. With 99 Companions in attendance, this is one of the largest turnouts I have seen recently. We kicked off the day with an excellent conferral of the Royal and Select Masters Degrees. We had a great luncheon by some special young women and their assistants (the Moms) which helped them to raise funds needed to attend the Job’s Daughters Supreme session. My utmost thanks and appreciation goes to MIPGM Naegele. Without his support, guidance and control over the whole degree, this would not have been possible. I also recommended limiting this degree conferral to every other year. Two reasons: 1. it takes a lot of time and attention for the chairman to have this happen. 2. It is a special degree, and the fact that it is not conferred every year will keep it that way.

### **Doings & Edicts**

At the Installation on October 25, 2014, I issued the following Edict.

All Councils must demonstrate their proficiency in opening and closing of the Council, by memory to the Grand Lecturer or his designated representative by the Semi-annual Assembly of 2015.

No companion may be installed Thrice Illustrious Master until he has demonstrated proficiency in opening, closing, and conferring the Royal Master or Select Master Degree to the Grand Lecturer, Deputy Grand Lecturer, or their Designated Representative, prior to the 2015 Semi-annual Convocation.

Following the 2015 Semi-Annual Convocation, no companion may be installed Thrice Illustrious Master until he has demonstrated proficiency in conferring both



the Royal Master and Select Master Degrees to the Grand Lecturer, Deputy Grand Lecturer or their Designated Representative, prior to the 2016 Semi-annual Convocation.

The Furniture and History lecture, along with the Charges may be given by any Companion, as long as he is proficient in the part.

In February, I had the pleasure to travel to the home of Piscataway Chapter RAM, present a dispensation, and open for the first time, Samuel Clemens Council UD. With the passion that the companions of Piscataway Chapter have shown for the York Rite, we felt that this is the logical next step.

I had the unfortunate task of addressing one situation that had been allowed to continue for quite some time. I contacted both Concordia #1 and Acacia #24 and have asked them to once again split from each other. My recommendation was to have Acacia #24, begin to meet in conjunction with Baltimore Chapter RAM. And as I understand it, this has been meet.

We held our Semi-Annual assembly at Enoch Council #10 in Frederick and I thank them for the hospitality that the Grand Council received. Prior to the meeting, the PTIM degree was conferred on three worthy candidates (Alex Rodriguez of Jerusalem #2, John Greer of Salem #11, and Art Hebbeler of Samuel Clemens UD). I would also like to thank the cast and to commend them for their ritual excellence in this conferral.

Our Councils continue to move forward to the future. Some still need some help and others are helping out where they can. I must give and 'honorable mention' to Jerusalem #2, for taking their show on the road and traveling to several other Councils to assist and confer the Council Degrees.

### **Travel**

With certain demands from my work and a situation that arose in my personal life, I have not been able to do as much as I had hoped. I had to cancel several visitations at the last minute or postpone them to a later time. I did have the pleasure to travel with the MEGHP Randall Watson, to the Grand Assembly of New Jersey and also to the Grand Assembly of Connecticut. Where we also had the pleasure of seeing a fellow Marylander installed as their Grand High Priest.

I was also able to make several Masonic youth functions and represented your Grand Council. While I mention the youth, our future, I must continue to

encourage your support for all three organizations – Job’s Daughters, Rainbow and of course, DeMolay. Each of these teaches leadership and skills to our young ladies and men so that they become better adults.

At the Semi-Annual, I announced that I would reinstitute the “Council of Excellence” which MIPGM Naegele instituted in his term. I have been working on the outline of the program and wished to present it here. However, time has slipped away and it is still not ready to be re-introduced at this time. I also had the hope of kicking off a mentor program or a ‘companion-to-companion’ program which is still on the drawing board but not yet complete.

Through the due diligence of our Grand Recorder, Companion Naegele, all dispensations and wavier of jurisdiction were handle in a timely and efficient manner.

MWGM Kenneth S. Wyvill, Jr. issued an edict dated November 24, 2014 establishing an official Attitude of Prayer to be used at all Masonic functions and ceremonies; consisting of placing the hand over the heart and bowing the head slightly. Although some may argue that in Council, this is a sign used in the Select Master’s Degree, the Attitude of Prayer has been adopted also by the Grand Chapter of RAM of MD, and is also adopted by this Grand Council.

Finally, I wish to express a thank you to all who support York Rite Masonry in MD.
